Spiritual and Moral Development

Year 8 Home Learning task 1

For Spiritual and Moral Development (SMD) you will have a 3 hour homework project which can be worked on over three weeks. You will be set one project per term which compliments the unit you will be studying. Background to the task.

You may also like to think about how these beliefs would affect your actions - for example if you feel that we should not damage the environment then you might include a drawing of yourself doing some recycling. Your work should be well presented and suitable for display.
